The kitchenette is equipped with a microwave, toaster oven, and a two-burner cooktop. Access to the kitchenette is only granted with prior permission, special dietary needs that cannot be met through the Sodexo kitchen, or while staying in the dorms over Thanksgiving and Spring Break.
